

Greetings from the Recorders Desk,

As we endeavor to arrive back at some form of "Normal Life", it's troubling to witness the struggles that our country is going thru with not only the pandemic but also with our nations heritage and the leaders that formed this great country. As the "New Normal" works its way into our everyday lives, it's now more important than ever to be kind to one another and "do unto others as you would have them do unto you"! Let's all get through this, TOGETHER!

As your temple remains somewhat closed to the general public, we have been able to complete numerous projects in and around the building. One of the more important projects that we're trying to remedy is the safety of our parking surface for those that use the facility. As you know, prior to the pandemic, one of our main goals for this year was to tear up and resurface the entire paved areas of the property. Over the years, the asphalt has deteriorated in several places and subsequently produced a fairly significant health risk for our membership and also our tenant from across the street who rents parking space from us. With that said, we have received a very generous offer from a local asphalt vendor, along with a gift of the transportation costs to supply us with materials needed to fill the numerous holes around our facility.

On Saturday August 8th, we will be having a "Workday" here at the temple to remove the loose debris from the potholes, prep the areas of concern, insert the adhesive material along the edges for the new pavement to adhere to, and basically ready the dangerous areas for new pavement. Then, on a day yet to be determined (Likely a weekday) we will schedule the delivery of material to fill the holes. Fortunately, our fraternity has several nobles with experience and numerous pieces of equipment that they will provide to us in order to properly fill and compact the hot top. This entire effort will hopefully buy us a couple more years of use before we HAVE to repave the facility.

Consequently, we are asking for the help of all nobles to assist us with the manpower needs. Much like the call for help last summer dealing with "The Flood", many hands will make for light work. The generosity of the 30 or more nobles and their lady's last July was overwhelming. Your efforts resulted in something that we couldn't have completed without all who instantly showed up when the cry for help was put out. Our present situation, while still very important, is not such a panic but something that our fraternity will benefit from and indeed help remedy a somewhat dangerous travel condition.

Your Shrine Center thanks you in advance for any help that you can lend to this effort. Incidentally, we'll likely have a small bar-b-que to nourish those who provide the work force.

In closing, please remember the annual dues invoices will go out by the first of September. Please try to update any of your contact info on the back of the paperwork so that we have an accurate data base in which to communicate with you.
