

of your intentions when it comes to use of the facility. It's certain that this Temple belongs to us. Anah Shriners and its clubs and units. And we as Shriners have first dibs However, we have enormous, fixed expenditures including +/- \$4,000.00 a month light bill and a \$20,000.00 annual heating and air-conditioning expense. With that said, outside rentals are a big part of our income and a much-needed evil when it comes to keeping our dues as one of the least expensive in all of Shrinedom. Unfortunately, juggling events and squeezing in all the various activities that we as Shriners need to conduct becomes somewhat cumbersome at times. (Keep in mind we currently have some 23 units and 13 clubs, all vying for time and space within our structure)

As I mentioned last month: PLEASE keep in mind the possibility of a "Per-Capita" increase as proposed by Shriners International. The "Call" of the 149th Imperial Session to be held the first week in July once again carries with it a piece of legislation to increase the individual per-capita dues from \$30.00 per noble to \$50.00 per noble. This alone would raise your annual dues from our current \$70.00 per year to \$90.00 (With no increase to your beloved Anah Shrine Temple). While there's no guarantee this will happen, this is the 3rd year in a row with it being one of the major topics of discussion.

Again, thank you all for your efforts in making these last couple weeks of our two fine Shrine Circuses such a success. Anah Strong is more than just a slogan, it's what we are and what we do. Thank You!





Should there be a widow who hasn't heard from me, please call me if you would like to join this fine group of ladies and enjoy the time with us . Always a great group with good conversation.


