If you click on that button, it will take you to another site where you can use your credit card and once you complete the transaction you will see your dues as being up to date immediately. We are transitioning away from PayPal, so that option will no longer be available. Again, if you are not comfortable with computers, you can call me, and I'll put the information in for you or you can still pay your dues with a check through the mail.

Speaking of dues, there are currently 75 nobles that still owe 2023 (and 2024) dues and 185 who owe for 2024. What a great time to check out WebFez and get your dues up to date! The membership committee and/or Divan members will be periodically making phone calls to remind you, because beginning this year if you are one year in arrears you will be suspended. That is not something we want to do, so please work on getting your dues paid.




It was such a great meal and a good time, if you did miss it you missed a fun evening.
